CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mary Jane Newman, Executrix has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump, tank and pipelines for commercial (store and bar) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 4, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N 1/2 corner of said Sec. 4 bears N. 1° 28' 15" E., 1,704 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Mary Jane Newman
Post-office address: San Francisco, California
Amount of appropriation: 0.01 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.2 m.g. annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: November 29, 1954

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped to a pressure tank; it is then distributed by pipelines to Lots 3 and 4 of Block 6 of Replat of Aeroville (within W 1/2 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 4, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B. & M.) where it is used in a store and bar.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
