CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harvey E. Wright has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well No. 1) through well, pump, tank and distribution system for commercial (bar and trailer court) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 1, T. 47 N., R. 64 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of Sec. 14, T. 47 N., R. 64 E., M.D.B. & M., bears S. 15° 50' 13" W., 12,602.30 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 0.12 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 26, 1957

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped through a pressure tank and distribution system to the S 1/4 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 1, T. 47 N., R. 64 E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used to serve a bar and 15 trailer spaces.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
