CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Fred W. Byrne has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, and portable sprinkler system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 2, T. 35 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 2 bears S. 32° 24' E., 1,421.5 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address: Winnemucca, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.50 c.f.s., but not to exceed 43.24 ac. ft. annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 19, 1959

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 10.81 acres in NW 1/4 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 2, T. 35 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
