CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

J. A. Millar, State Water Right Surveyor has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring through dam, pipeline, pump and sprinklers for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 18, T. 14 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said Sec. 18 bears S. 24° 00' W., 5,310 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of said Statutes, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Charles E. Stewart
Post-office address: Gardnerville, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.067 c.f.s., but not to exceed 16 ac. ft. annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: April 11, 1955

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 4.0 acres in E 1/2 E 1/2 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 18, T. 14 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
