CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harold W. Baker, Jr. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from drain ditch (drainage and seepage water which originates from the Main Walker River) through headgate, ditches, dikes and pipes for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 31, T. 15 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of Sec. 36, T. 15 N., R. 24 E., bears S. 37° 32' W., 4,373 feet situate in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation 4.0 c.f.s., but not to exceed 992 ac.ft. per season
Period of use, from April 1st to November 1st of each year

* The total duty of water for the land under this certificate shall not exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre per season from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
