CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Howard Parish has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, pressure tank and pipe for domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 18, T. 18 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 18 bears N. 2° 00' W., 2,364.3 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Howard Parish
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0016 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: February 3, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped to a pressure tank from where it is conveyed by pipeline to the place of use for household, lawn, garden use and domestic livestock watering within SW 1/4 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 18, T. 18 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
