

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Domingo Segura has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

South Spring through dam, pipeline and troughs for stock watering purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 13 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B. & M. (unsurveyed) or at a point from which the N.W. corner of Sec. 1, T. 13 N., R. 50 E. bears N. 34° 55' W., 20,340 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Segura Brothers (Antonio and Domingo)

Post-office address Eureka, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.014 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 2,000 sheep and 50 head of cattle

Period of use, from May 9th to August 12th of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 3, 1951

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted by a small dam through a pipeline to troughs where it is used to water livestock within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
