CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harry H. Hughes, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, pipe and ditches for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 22, T. 2 S., R. 35 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said Sec. 22 bears S. 60° W., 150 feet

situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada. Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.405, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:
