

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Russell G. Hales, secretary has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump and distribution system for industrial purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 3, T. 21 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Sec. 3 bears N. 69° 25' E., 2,450 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Ideal Asphalt Paving Co., Inc.
Post-office address: Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.44 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: June 24, 1957

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped through a distribution system to Ideal Asphalt Paving Co., Inc. located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used for an asphalt concrete plant.

This certificate is subject to revocation when water is available from the Las Vegas Valley Water District.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
