CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Ted Ax has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring (Allen Springs) through ditch and pipeline for mining and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 33, T. 16 N., R. 29 E., M.D.B. & M., (unsurveyed) or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said Sec. 33 bears S. 54° 25' W., 6,273 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937
NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of said Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 18, 1956

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is collected from a spring and is conveyed through a ditch and pipeline to a trailer house and "cold pond" located within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 33, T. 16 N., R. 29 E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used for mining and domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
