CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. A. Roof has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Cane Springs through pond, pump, pipeline, tank and distribution system for milling and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 34, T. 41 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 34 bears N. 49° 00' W., 660 feet

situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of 1937 Statutes, has determined the date,

source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Warren A. Roof, Jr.

Post-office address Winnemucca, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.125 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 2, 1955

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is collected in a pond and pumped through a pipeline to a tank and thence conveyed through a distribution system to the mill located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
