CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. M. Marshall, Petroleum Engineer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well No. 1) through well, pump and distribution system for industrial purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 35, T. 9 N., R. 57 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Sec. 35 bears N. 67° 45' 20" E., 3,333.85 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937
NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of said statute, has determined the date,

source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 0.0065 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 1, 1955

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped through a distribution system to boilers, radiators and other oil field operations located within NE 1/4 NW 1/4 and N 1/2 SW 1/4 Section 35, T. 9 N., R. 57 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
