

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank W. Groves, Director has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, tank and distribution system for domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 19 N., R. 29 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said Sec. 20 bears S. 33° 16' 59" W., 3,059.05 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0267 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation June 19, 1959

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped through a pipeline to a pressure tank; it is then conveyed by a distribution system to the Sierra District Headquarters establishment of the Nevada Fish and Game Commission located within NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 20, T. 19 N., R. 29 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
