CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Oliver A. Shermer, Jr. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, pipeline, ponds and ditches for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 30, T. 13 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of Sec. 25, T. 13 N., R. 23 E., bears S. 62° 44' W., 7,902.0 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 1.0 c.f.s., but not to exceed 136 ac.ft. annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 1, 1952

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 34 acres in SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 30, T. 13 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
