CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. Frandsen Loomis, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Lake Tahoe through pump, pipeline and distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 2 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4) Sec. 15, T. 13 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the northerly meander corner between Secs. 15 and 16 bears N. 7° 13' W., 873 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 under the provisions of has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

\* Amount of appropriation 0.160 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation April 19, 1955

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted from Lake Tahoe by means of a pump and conveyed by pipeline and distribution system to the place of use located within Lot 2 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4) and SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 15, T. 13 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used to serve 4 houses and 2 laundries.

\* The amount of appropriation is limited to 50 gallons of water per capita per day during the non-summer season.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
