CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James A. Seigla, manager has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Truckee River (Claim No. 125) through dam, Highland Ditch, reservoir and distribution system for quasi-municipal (cemetery) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 19 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.E. corner of said Sec. 9 bears S. 75° 16' E., 1,650 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of said statute has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from As xx Decreed of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 2, 1875

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is conveyed from the Truckee River through the Highland Ditch to a small reservoir from which it is conveyed by a distribution system to the place of use located within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 9, W 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 10, T. 19 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used for cemetery purposes.

* This certificate changes the manner and place of use of Claim No. 125, Truckee River Final Decree in Equity, Docket No. A-3, in the District Court of the United States of America in and for the District of Nevada.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
