CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles C. Armuth, Jr., agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Jewkes Spring through an earthen pond for stock watering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 Sec. 23, T. 32 N., R. 59 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of Sec. 24, T. 32 N., R. 59 E., M.D.B. & M., bears N. 53° 27' E., 7,306.64 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Wells, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0094 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 300 cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation December 27, 1961

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is stored in an earthen pond located within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 23, T. 32 N., R. 59 E., M.D.B. & M., and cattle water from the pond.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
