CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Paul Inchauspe has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Laborde Well No. 4 through well, pump, windmill, pipe and tanks for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 15, T. 24 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of Sec. 13, T. 24 N., R. 44 E., bears N. 84° 26' E., 10,679 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Austin, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0062 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 200 cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 14, 1930

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped through a pipe line to tanks where it is used to water cattle within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
