CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settelmeyer, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well No. 2) through drilled well, pump, windmill and trough for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 22, T. 26 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 22 bears S. 78° E., 580 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0125 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 400 cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 11, 1960

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped by windmill to a metal watering trough located in SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 22, T. 26 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used to water cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
