CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank G. Arcularius has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Spanish Spring Well) through well, pump, storage tank, pipe line and trough for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 36, T. 7 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of Sec. 23, T. 7 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B. & M., bears N. 27° 30' W., 15,067 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: F. H. Arcularius and Sons (Frank G. and Howard Arcularius)
Post-office address: Bishop, California
Amount of appropriation: 0.031 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle
Period of use, from: October 1st to May 20th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 14, 1949

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped through a pipe line to a storage tank, then conveyed by pipe line to a trough located within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 36, T. 7 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used to water livestock.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
