WHEREAS, A. E. Millar, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump, storage tank and pipelines for milling purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 17, T.13N., R.25E., M.D.B.& M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 16, T.13N., R.25E., M.D.B.& M., bears N. 87°54'43" E., a distance of 1,188.66 feet, situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:


Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well 610 feet deep, 14-inch diameter casing equipped with a pump and motor, thence conveyed by a pipeline to a storage tank located within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 8, T.13N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M. The water is pumped through pipelines to the ore beneficiation plant located within portions of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 8, the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 16 and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 17, T.13N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used for concentrating and leaching copper ore.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
