CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert W. Millard, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

an underground source through well, pump and sprinklers for irrigation purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 28, T. 22 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Sec. 28 bears N. 44° 36' E., 1,800.0 feet

situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:
