CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harry H. Hughes, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Little Blind Spring through ditches and laterals for irrigation purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 1, T. 8 N., R. 57 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said Sec. 1 bears S. 57° 09' W., 982 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation 0.10 c.f.s., but not to exceed 40 ac. ft. annually

Period of use, from January to December of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 13, 1959

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

10.0 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 1, T. 8 N., R. 57 E., M.D.B. & M.

* The land irrigated under this certificate is also irrigated from other sources, therefore, the total duty from all sources shall not exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
