CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Steve Landa has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring through pipe line, troughs and storage pond for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 26, T. 20 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SW 1/4 corner of said Sec. 26 bears S. 23°45' W., 329.70 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Landa Brothers, a co-partnership of Stevan and Marcelino Landa

Post-office address: Reno, Nevada

Amount of appropriation: 0.00581 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 3,000 head of sheep

Period of use, from March 1st to December 1st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: April 14, 1958

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water from a developed spring is conveyed in a southerly direction by 180 feet of 1 1/2 inch plastic pipe to five 160 gallon sheep troughs, thence into a storage pond for watering sheep, all situated within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 35, T. 20 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
