CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Kimball Elquist - Chairman has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, storage tank and distribution system for municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 32N., R. 45E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of said Sec. 20 bears N. 57° 12' 48" W., 1622.75 feet. situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Town of Battle Mountain
Post-office address: Battle Mountain, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 1.782 c.f.s. or not to exceed 1.517 mgd.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 12, 1958

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped to a 75,000 gallon storage tank; thence into a distribution system located within the following places of use: NE 1/4 SW 1/4, NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SW 1/4 SW 1/4 and SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 17, NE 1/4 NW 1/4, NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SW 1/4 NW 1/4 and SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 20 all in T. 32N., R. 45E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used to serve the Town of Battle Mountain.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
