CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settelmeyer, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well No. 1) through well, pump and ditches for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 33, T. 29N., R. 49E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Sec. 33 bears N. 15° 17' E., 896.0 feet.
