CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank Lancaster has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cabin Springs No. 1 through pipe line and trough for stock watering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 6, T. 20S., R. 58E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the E. corner of said Sec. 6, bears N. 76° 45' E., 3328.0 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0031 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 100 cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 26, 1959

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from a spring and is conveyed to a trough by means of 20 feet of 3/4 inch pipe where it is used to water cattle within NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 6, T. 20S., R. 58E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
