CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Eugene C. Sprout, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, pipe line, trough and sump for stock watering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Sec. 14, T. 45 N., R. 28 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said Sec. 14, bears S. 29° 44' 14" W., 798.0 feet. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Boccardo Corporation dba Alder Creek Cattle Company  
Post-office address San Jose, California  
Amount of appropriation 0.0125 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 400 cattle.  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation March 31, 1959

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped to a stock watering trough and a sump located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 400 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
