CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Philip E. Palm, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, pipe line and sprinklers for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 15, T. 2 S. R. 35 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 15, bears N. 32° 45' E., 2,472 feet. situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937
NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of said statute, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from April 1st through October 15th of each year
\* Date of priority of appropriation October 21, 1949

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
40.0 acres in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 15, T. 2 S., R. 35 E., M.D.B. & M.

\* This certificate changes the point of diversion of Application No. 13123, hence the priority of appropriation is the same as Application No. 13123.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
