CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Paul Gemmill has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, storage tank and distribution system for municipal and domestic

purposes: The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 5, T. 2 S., R. 68 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said Sec. 5, bears S. 75° 42' 51" W., 2,382.16 feet. situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Panaca Farmstead Water Association, Inc.
Post-office address: Panaca, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 1.0 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 2, 1955

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 12 inches in diameter, 170 feet deep, equipped with a 30 h.p. pump. The water is pumped into a 50,000 gallon storage tank and then into a distribution system which serves the Town of Panaca, Nevada located in SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 4, E 1/4 E 1/4 Section 8 and W 1/4 Section 9, T. 2 S., R. 68 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
