CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harry H. Hughes has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and ditches for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 16 S., R. 49 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 9, bears N. 88° 06' W., 2,577 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.
