CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settalmeyer - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and ditches for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 16, T. 30 N., R. 59 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of Sec. 8, T. 30 N., R. 59 E., M.D.B. & M., bears N. 55° 08' W., 9,425.80 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:


Name of appropriator: Smith Brothers Ox Ranch, a partnership of Albert N. Smith and Paul W. Smith

Amount of appropriation: 0.06684 c.f.s. but not to exceed a yearly duty of 29.0 ac.ft. per season.

Period of use, from April 1st to October 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: August 25, 1954

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 8.0 acres in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 16, T. 30 N., R. 59 E., M.D.B. & M.



The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
