CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Jack Prenderville, Manager has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (well No. 2) through well, pump, pipe line and distribution system for municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 27, T. 7 N., R. 35 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said Sec. 27 bears S. 37° 51' W., 1,665.4 feet, situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Mina Water System
Post-office address: Mina, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.168 c.f.s. but not to exceed 39.8 mg. annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: April 25, 1961

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped into a distribution system which serves the Town of Mina, Nevada located in the W 1/2 Section 8, T. 6 N., R. 35 E., M.D.B. & M. This source is also known as Simon Road Well No. 2.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
