CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W.H. Settelmeyer - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (well No. 1) through well, pump and distribution system for domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 Sec. 14, T. 34 N. R. 55 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Sec. 14 bears N. 51° 05' E., 490.0 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Paul W. and Betty R. Bear

Post-office address Elko, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.04456 c.f.s. but not to exceed 1,440 gpd.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation June 1, 1960

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped into a storage tank; thence through a distribution system to service a house and yard located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
