CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Ben Lewis, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Dog Pound Well) through drilled well, pump, storage tank and distribution system for sanitary (Dog Pound) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 15, T. 15 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of said Sec. 15 bears S. 63° 30' 40" W., 2,782 feet, situated in Ormsby County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: City of Carson City
Post-office address: Carson City, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.05 c.f.s. but not to exceed 11.795 mg. annually.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 18, 1961

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped to a storage tank into a distribution system and is used at the Dog Pound for sanitary purposes. The place of use is located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
