CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. V. Caselli has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Warm Springs Creek through dam and ditch for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 4 N., R. 50 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.E. corner of said Sec. 20, bears S. 28° 30' E., 2,745.0 feet, situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

10.0 acres in the N 1/2 N 1/2 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 21, T. 4 N., R. 50 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
