

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Hazel Green has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Violet Spring through developed spring and pipe line for mining and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 25, T. 14 N., R. 67 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the N 1/2 corner of Sec. 26, T. 14 N., R. 67 E., M.D.B. & M. bears N. 81° 20' W., 5,065 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Post-office address Ely, Nevada
 Amount of appropriation 0.50 c.f.s. but not to exceed 78.85 m.g. per season
 Period of use, from April 1st to November 30th of each year
 Date of priority of appropriation August 3, 1959

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water from the developed spring is collected in a screened pool from which it is conveyed by 5,430 feet of pipe line to the place of use located within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 24, T. 14 N., R. 67 E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used for mining (washing gold bearing gravel) and domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
