CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harry H. Hughes, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Middle Indian Spring through pipe line, service tank and distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 26, T. 11 S., R. 46 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 26 bears S. 22° 55' E., 1,792 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.055 c.f.s. but not to exceed 12,975 m.g. annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 10, 1957

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from Middle Indian Spring and conveyed by approximately 4 3/4 miles of 2" galvanized pipe to a service tank, thence through a distribution system to a service station, restaurant, garden and residential dwelling, located within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 9, T. 12 S., R. 46 E., M.D.B. & M. The waters under this certificate are commingled with the water under Permit 17328, Certificate 5654, at a point in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 26, T. 11 S., R. 46 E., M.D.B. & M., and the amount of water from both sources shall not exceed 25.95 m.g. annually.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
