CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Harold Bramwell has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 34, T. 14 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 34 bears N. 33° 31' W. 1,175.0 feet. situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Harold Bramwell
Post-office address: Ogden, Utah
Amount of appropriation: 0.00223 c.f.s. but not to exceed 1440 gpd.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: November 16, 1956

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and pumped by pipe line to a distribution system located within the place of use. The water serves one dwelling located within the E 1/4 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 34, T. 14 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M., and is used for domestic purposes only.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
