CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, D. W. Heckethorn has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (geophysical drill hole DH # 2) through well, pipe line and tank for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 6, T. 11 N., R. 67 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of said Sec. 6 bears N. 12° 17' 48" W., 846.46 feet. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0022 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 200 cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 8, 1959

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled artesian well and is conveyed by 125 feet of 3/4 inch plastic pipe to a 500 gallon metal tank located within NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 6, T. 11 N., R. 67 E., M.D.B. & M., and there used to water 200 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
