CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, R. S. Leighton has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and distribution system for municipal

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 Sec. 4, T. 19 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 4, bears S. 48° 31' W., 991.87 feet, situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Sierra Pacific Power Company

Post-office address Reno, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 4.0 c.f.s. but not to exceed 943.7 m.g. annually.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation June 19, 1958

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped through a distribution system to the City of Sparks, Nevada, where it is used for municipal purposes within Sections 4 and 5, T. 19 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
