Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.025, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Ruby Valley, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.00223 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 100 cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation February 15, 1954

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is conveyed from the developed spring area through 180 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe line to a trough located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used for the watering of livestock.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
