CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (well no. 1) through drilled well, pump and ditches for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 5, T. 36 N., R. 60 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Sec. 5 bears N. 3° 10' 22" E., 1,339.2 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Table with 4 columns: Acres, NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SE 1/4 NE 1/4. Rows include 1.0 acres in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 5, T. 36 N., R. 60 E., M.D.B. & M.; 9.1 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4; 34.6 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4; 29.6 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4; 74.3 Total Acres.

* The total duty of water for the land under this certificate shall not exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre per season from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
