CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, O. M. Brockliss has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and ditches for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 11, T. 12 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Sec. 10, T. 12 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M., bears S. 89°15' W., 3,987.02 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

\* Amount of appropriation 0.0125 c.f.s. but not to exceed 8.0 ac.ft. annually.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 9, 1960

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 2.0 acres in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 11, T. 12 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M.

\* The total duty of water for the land from all sources under this certificate shall not exceed the duty per acre to be established by the Carson River Final Decree.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
