


THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles M. Barr has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and sprinkler system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 35, T. 16 S., R. 48 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Sec. 35 bears N. 84° E., 800 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 569.025, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:
