

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Edmund Miller has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from underground (well No. 3), Smith Valley Artesian Basin through well, pump, pond, pipe line, ditches and sprinkler system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 13, T. 11 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Sec. 13 bears N. 11° 53' E., 2,667.5 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
 Date of priority of appropriation December 19, 1958

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
15 acres in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 13, T. 11 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
