

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John W. Griswold, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Whiskey Flat Well) through drilled well, windmill, pipe line and trough for stock watering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 19, T. 5 N., R. 31 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of said Sec. 19 bears N. 63° 48' 36" W., 3,712.6 feet. situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: U.S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management

Post-office address: Carson City, Nevada

Amount of appropriation: 0.0031 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 100 cattle the following
Period of use, from November 1st to April 15th of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: May 15, 1963

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped by a windmill through a pipe line to a 7,780 gallon concrete tank located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 100 cattle and domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
