

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. M. Lamb has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Mustang Spring through a collection box, pipe line and tank for stock watering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 Sec. 25, T. 26 N., R. 36 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.E. corner of said Sec. 25 bears S. 63° 30' E., 2,142 feet. situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Dixie Valley Cattle Corporation
 Post-office address Fallon, Nevada
 Amount of appropriation 0.005 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 150 cattle
 Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
 Date of priority of appropriation January 8, 1963

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is collected in a redwood collection box within the spring area and diverted by pipe line to a tank located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 150 cattle and domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
