CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER


WHEREAS, Bennett J. Vasey has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from unnamed spring - Lee Canyon through storage tank and pipe line for quasi-municipal (subdivision) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 2, T. 19 S., R. 56 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of Sec. 35, T. 18 S., R. 56 E., M.D.B. & M., bears N. 00°00'07" W., 601.5 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of 503-23405, has determined the date,

source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 18, 1956

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed and stored in a 9,000 gallon tank at the spring area, thence is transported by 2 inch pipe line to the place of use located in the W 1/2 SE 1/4 Section 35, T. 18 S., R. 56 E., M.D.B. & M. The water is used for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes to supply 5 houses, 1 cabin and 3 camping areas.



The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
