CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS James R. Kilduff has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and ditches for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 22, T. 10 N., R. 22 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Sec. 22 bears N. 6° 14' E. 1,946.30 feet. situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation 4.0 c.f.s. but not to exceed a duty of 320 ac-ft. per season

Period of use, from March 1 to October 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation November 16, 1955

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

Table with 7 columns: Acres, Section, Township, Range, Meridian, and other details. Rows include 8.0 acres in NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 23, T. 10 N., R. 22 E., M.D.B. & M., and a total of 80.0 acres.

* The total duty of water for the land under this certificate shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre annually from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
